## Introduction:

The advance mobile veterinary cervices reach to 10 Bedouins settlements as in visits schedule and during these visits 35 Cases take treatment. Increase the number of cases due to appear infectious disease in camels work in tourism in St. Katherine area because purchase camels from Sharm Elsheikh and Elareish city's and enter without quarantine or veterinary unit examination. During visits of MVU for Bedouins settlements and calls from cameleer to help (confidence) the disease was monitored. The cases care by the doctor and take suitable treatments then isolated away from other animals without working in tourism. The doctor controls the disease by distribution and calls from Bedouins.
